As a reminder, the **Sussex Masters** is a County track and field competition held with eight Sussex Athletics clubs for participants aged 35 and over. Lewes AC form a team with Haywards Heath Harriers. Events range from 200m – 5000m on the track, Shot, Discus, Javelin ,Long Jump and more in the field and finish with fun relays on the track. The meets tend to take place on glorious sunny evenings and the spirit is friendly, fun and inclusive.

The **Southern Athletics League** is also a track and field event for all adults from u17 upwards and provides all age ranges with the chance to compete in track and field disciplines.

These matches are a fantastic opportunity to try a new event (or one you haven't done for a very long time) and enjoy representing the club. Should you wish to take part (I really recommend it!) you can contact the team captains to declare your interest.

#### Strength & Conditioning

- Sessions are open to all members (At first please email us to register your interest, details further down) with a maximum class size. Preference will be given to WSFRL/ESSCL/SCCL squad members if needed.

**Goal Races for Lewes AC** 

#### Cross Country/ Off road/ Mixed:

- WSFRL (West Sussex Fun Run League) Our goal is to increase particpation here, and it is an excellent entry point for newer runners and those that want to progress from a parkrun for example. The point is not to win (remember we get a point just for everyone who runs), but for people to experience racing and see whether they enjoy it. - Plan to include sports massage, talks and other running themed activities to be available such as pilates / yoga





12. Youth Development League – Upper Age Group Lewes Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> April

#### Lewes

The Youth Development League is an England-wide league designed to broaden competition for Under 20 young athletes.

Lewes AC is part of Team Sussex, a composite team that includes East Grinstead AC, Eastbourne Rovers AC, Haywards Heath Harriers, and Worthing Harriers.

England is divided into regions - we are 'Southern' – which contain Divisions at Premier, Level 1 and Level 2. As with football teams can be promoted or relegated between different level of Division: Team Sussex currently is at the lowest level.

At the end of the season the top two clubs in the Premier Division in each region compete for a national title.

Thanks, as ever, to Dave Leach for the Lewes highlights when we hosted the first league match in the Southern 2A Division.

## 13. Events Calendar

#### West Sussex Fun Run League

Four WSFRL events for 2024 have already been and gone: the Hangover 5 miles (Hill Barn Worthing), Run Your Heart Out 8K (Crawley), Lewes Easter Fun Run 10k and the Hedgehoppers 5 miles.

Lewes AC has fairly recently come first in this competition after years of neglect, and this year the club has identified regaining position as a target. The rules of the WSFRL mean every member club has to hold an event and with 17 clubs that is quite a commitment. The variety of events is a plus, but there is a congested period at the height of Summer with events on both Sundays and Wednesdays. Pluses for the WSFRL also include that fixtures are published at the beginning of the year which helps personal planning and that each event has to have access to proper toilets! Neither of these is the case with the East Sussex Sunday Cross Country League.

The competitive focus of the league is on club performance rather than the individual. The scoring system gives some points for up to 25 runners for simply turning up.

## Sussex Grand Prix Races 2024

This league is dedicated to road races. In the list below you may notice that some stand-out Sussex road races based in Brighton and Worthing are missing. An aim of the league is to avoid some massively attended events which, despite the nod towards charity, are essentially commercial

undertakings. This is not an attempt to stop runners enjoying these events, but to broaden the options.

Sussex has quite a few hills, and with the exception of some races in the SGP such as Hastings 5 miles Phoenix 10k, and the Hove Prom 10k, most feature some hills (but no mud). So they may not be attractive for those after a PB.

Lewes AC has decided not to target these events. The two exceptions are one mid-week evening event of the series, the Phoenix 10k, and our own Lewes Downland 10 miles. The Ammonite editor is the Lewes AC representative on the SGP committee (along with Peter Masters who represents Sussex Athletics) and the editor is also the SGP Treasurer so they will have a bias.

It would be unfair to expect other Sussex clubs to race at our event (and generate income) but discourage our runners attending their events. So the fact that they are not being targeted does not prevent you from entering them if you so wished. (I had already put in a lot of entries before the club plan was announced).

The league has both a club element competing for the Steve Ovett cup (donated by Ovett when he was clearing out his house before going to Australia) which Lewes AC will never win, and individual overall and age categories which are worth attention. Three events out of the twelve have taken place, but it is your best six races that count.
